Language Arts Class

Supplies:

- Planner
- Lined, hole-punched binder paper.
- Pencils, Pens, Highlighters.
- Spiral Notebook

You will be EXPECTED to keep a well-organized binder. Having your papers in order will enable you to see the sequence of skills you are mastering. We will have weekly binder checks to help students learn the habit of organization.

Work that cannot be read or answers without appropriate explanations WILL NOT receive full credit. EVERY minute of class time is valuable so be prepared to work the full period daily.
